Finalists from Katy and Fort Bend County Emerge from 2020 Houston Public Media Spelling Bee

The two spellers advance to the national spelling bee in Maryland

HOUSTON, March 8, 2020 – Adustiosis. That word earned Keerthana Krishnan the top spot at one of the largest and most competitive regional spelling bees in the country. The winning word, which means a reddish discoloration of the skin of a citrus fruit, came up during the fourteenth round of the competition.

This was Krishnan's second appearance at the regional competition. She is an eighth-grade student at Beckendorff Junior High in Katy ISD. Sajid Fahmid, an eighth-grade student at Leeman Junior High in Lamar Consolidated ISD, was this year's runner-up.



Krishnan and Fahmid advance to the [93rd Scripps National Spelling Bee](#) May 24-29 in Maryland. They will face off spellers from across the country for the national championship. The bee finals will broadcast live on ESPN Thursday, May 29 at 6 pm.

Houston Public Media hosts and broadcasts this major spelling bee competition annually as part of its commitment to education. This marks the twelfth year that Houston Public Media has staged this prestigious academic competition.
